The PBM group is once again organizing the STAIRS DESIGN AWARDS competition for student architects. Registration started on Monday, October 17.

Stairs Design Awards #3, an innovative competition

The idea is simple: design an innovative staircase. Architect students are invited to imagine a staircase with a strong identity, becoming a key architectural element, well beyond its basic functional role. The use of concrete must be obvious but other materials can be associated with it. The staircase must keep a staircase function, comply with accessibility rules and be feasible.

Conditions of participation

This competition is free and open to all students enrolled in a school of architecture in France, Belgium, Switzerland, Luxembourg, Germany or Spain for the year 2022-2023. 1st prize : 8 000 €

2nd prize : 5 000 €

3rd prize : 2 500 €

People's Choice Award : 1 500 €

Prize PBM : 1 500 € (internal voting by PBM Groupe employees)
